

Attention South Carolina Independent Pharmacies!
If you are in the State Employee (PEBA) Plan Please Read.

It has come to the attention of the South Carolina Pharmacy Association that independent pharmacies that **opened or changed ownership in the past two years**, may have been placed in the wrong MAC pricing list for the state employee (PEBA) program and you may be finding yourself underwater on many MAC reimbursements. SCPhA has been investigating this and have found at least six (6) independents who fit one of the two categories listed above. Upon further investigation we were also able to verify that this is a MAC pricing discrepancy. We are trying to rectify this situation and need your assistance to do so. If you are a PEBA 90-day Preferred Pharmacy, this may not apply as it relates to MAC pricing but we are checking anyway.

If your pharmacy either opened and/or was purchased in the past two years in SC and you are seeing underwater MAC pricing reimbursements, we need the following information to pass on to PEBA to make this right. We are also requesting that ESI make you whole back to the day your opened. Please provide SCPhA the following information at craig@scrx.org.

Date your pharmacy opened (either newly opened or under new ownership)
